2. Discuss, consider, and act on drainage issue for culvert under Santiago trail near 900 Santiago Trail:

Bob spoke with the homeowner to the west of the culvert and the homeowner advised both he and the other property owner filled in the ditch. Bob advised a solution would be to go in and recreate the ditch which could cost \$7,000-\$8,000. Many options were discussed for a possible solution including the district making repairs or holding the homeowners accountable to the repairs. Brian made a motion for staff to take whatever action is necessary to reform the drainage ditch 1007 and 1009 Santiago Trail.

Nick seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

3. Discuss, consider, and act on Renewal of Fire Contract with City of Lucas:

City of Lucas suggests we modify the contact which will show the district will have permanent automatic renewals unless the district tells them otherwise. Brian made a motion to direct staff to work with the City of Lucas on developing an amendment to the agreement with firefighting and emergency services to provide automatic one-year extensions on October 1 of each year.
