ORDER NO. 08192024.01

AN ORDER OF THE SEIS LAGOS UTILITY DISTRICT, TEXAS; AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S RATES AND RULES SECTION 5.1 FEE FOR FAILURE TO MEET REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING, SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Seis Lagos Utility District ("Board"), has investigated and determined that it would be advantageous and beneficial to the citizens of the Seis Lagos Utility District, Texas ("District") to amend the Rates and Rules Section 5.1 to reduce the fee for failure to meet requirements of the Rates and Rules; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Rates & Rules, as they presently exist and are amended herein, are necessary to protect the health safety and welfare of the public in regard to roadways, drainage, water connections and sewer connections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SEIS LAGOS UTILITY DISTRICT, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The legislative findings set forth above have been reviewed for compliance and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Amendment of Section 5.1. The District's Rates and Rules are hereby amended to revise Section 5.1 to reduce the fee as an optional action for the District for a customer's failure to adhere to all the stated requirements from \$3,000 to \$2,000. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to implement the amendment into the Rates and Rules kept in the District's Office and placed on the District's website.

SECTION 3: Savings/Repealing Clause. All provisions of any Order, resolution or policy in conflict with this Order are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed Order, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commence for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the Order. Any remaining portions of said Orders, resolutions or policies shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Severability. Should any section, subsection sentence, clause or phrase of this Order be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly



provided that all remaining portions of this Order shall remain in full force and effect. District hereby declares that it would have passed this Order, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase there of irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.


SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Order shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Directors and publication as required by law.
